HISTORY

- 1969 – Next Door is founded as a youth and young adult outreach program of Our Saviors Lutheran Church.
- 1971 – Next Door incorporates as a non-profit 501 (c)(3) organization.
- 1973 – Next Door opened its Cornerstone Children and Youth Center.
- 1974 – The Genesis Outpatient Alcohol and Drug Treatment program was opened.
- 1975 – Next Door began its home-based 'Early On' program.
- 1977 – Next Door's Home Start Program started.
- 1986 – The Adult Education (ABE/GED) program was founded.
- 1986 – New Frontiers Employment and summer youth employment programs began.
- 1987 – Next Door was given Hope Apartments on North 27th Street, providing permanent housing for low-income residents.
- 1989 – Next Door held its first annual Walk for Children event.
- 1992 – The newly renovated Helwig Family Community Center became the home of Next Door.
- 1993 – Next Door's first classroom-based Head Start program began.
- 1995 – Next Door shifted its focus to children from birth to 12 years of age.
- 1996 – Next Door received its Early Head Start demonstration grant.
- 1997 – Next Door began four and five year old kindergarten programs funded by the MPS.
- 1998 – Next Door Pediatrics, a collaboration with Children's Medical Group, opens at Next Door.
- 1999 – The Lifetime Learners program, a collaboration with Cardinal Stritch University, began offering college classes at Next Door.
- 2000 – Next Door receives a 3-year Fatherhood Demonstration Grant.
- 2002 – Next Door and the Buffett Family Foundation begin to develop the concept for The Educare Center of Milwaukee.
- 2004 – Next Door breaks ground for The Educare Center of Milwaukee.
- 2005 – The Educare Center of Milwaukee opens in September.
- 2005 – Next Door Charter School opens under a contract with Milwaukee Public Schools.
- 2007 – Next Door receives a Kresge Foundation grant for "Building a Future" capital campaign.
- 2007 – Renovation of Helwig Family Community Center completed.
- 2008 – New and revised web site launched.
- 2009 – Next Door Celebrates its 40th Anniversary.

Letter from Next Door Foundation's Executive Director and Board President



Dear Friends,

We are grateful to our generous donors who – in these very difficult economic times - continue to support Next Door Foundation's children and families who struggle daily with the harsh realities of living in the central city Milwaukee. We are truly blessed to have such a committed and responsive community believing in and supporting our capacity to work with families – and bring positive change to our city.

Children are born learning. Recent research tells us that investing in their first five years will ensure that more infants, toddlers, preschoolers and kindergartners, will become lifelong learners and give back to their community.

Next Door is always looking for ways to provide new opportunities for growth and development. Generous grants have allowed us expand our Early Head Start program to serve 212 families, with children from prenatal stages to 3-year-old; a Healthy Marriage program for parents of infants; and a Fatherhood program that supports new and expectant fathers. Next Door Foundation, in collaboration with Children's Hospital of Wisconsin, has added a second pediatric nurse practitioner to continue to ensure the highest level of comprehensive health care for our children. In addition, Next Door Foundation was nominated as a Wisconsin Center of Excellence for outstanding early education programming.

Some additional program highlights include:

- 970 children served through integrated programs for families and children to age 12;



- 13% of children received special education services;
- 204 children screened for potential disabilities. 83 children with diagnosed disabilities received direct services.
- Through the efforts of our health staff and family workers: 99% of families have a primary physician; 95% of children received all necessary immunizations; and more than 90% of these children receive timely lead screenings.



For Dr. Earnestine Willis, eliminating health disparities for children living in underserved communities is both her purpose and passion. Dr. Willis is a general pediatrician and has been a member of the Next Door Foundation's Board of Directors since 2001. Dr. Willis was drawn to Next Door because of the agency's "commitment to optimize the destiny of children and families in the Metcalfe Park area."

On the local and national level, Dr. Willis has been instrumental in establishing and evaluating wellness programs that empower impoverished and under-

privileged neighborhoods. Dr. Willis enjoys working with various service sectors that care for children, and believes that the coordination of community resources is the key to giving all children the opportunity to develop into their full potential.

Dr. Willis has taken the lead in implementing many health initiatives at Next Door. She was the founder of Next Door Pediatrics, a partnership with Children's Health Systems of Wisconsin that serves 3,000 patients.

MISSION

We support the intellectual, physical, spiritual and emotional development of children so they become self-sufficient, contributing members of the community.

Dr. Willis developed the Community Health Improvement in Milwaukee County (CHIMC), a program that ensures community-based partnerships are ethical and inclusive in conducting participatory research in local communities. She also created the Community Pediatric Training Initiative, a graduate medical education program, which helps place doctors in residency programs serving community based organizations like Next Door Foundation.

In addition to her work at Next Door, Dr. Willis has been with the Medical College of Wisconsin since 1995, serving as a professor in the Department of Pediatrics and the Director of the Center of the Advancement of Underserved Children. Dr. Willis received her Medical Degree and Master's in Public Health from Harvard Medical School and the Harvard School of Public Health, respectively. Dr. Willis is also a Robert Wood Johnson Health Policy Fellow and was the former chair of the Wisconsin Tobacco Control Board.

Since healthy children learn better, Dr. Willis emphasizes the importance of parents and professionals working in partnership to ensure that children get



routine health care and immunizations. Since parents are their children's best advocates, Next Door provides them with tools they can use.

Additionally, as a donor, Dr. Willis feels that giving to Next Door is a great investment in the future of our community, the city, and Wisconsin as a whole. To continue to strengthen the Metcalfe Park area, it is vital that health and educational programs are a priority. Work at the Next Door Foundation helps to ensure both. According to Dr. Willis, "since Next Door Foundation (the home of Educare) is such an essential provider of services to children and families, it is crucial to support them with your contributions, allowing them to sustain these outstanding services into our future."

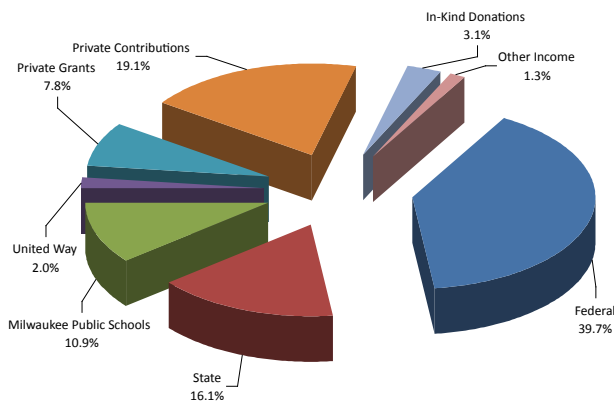

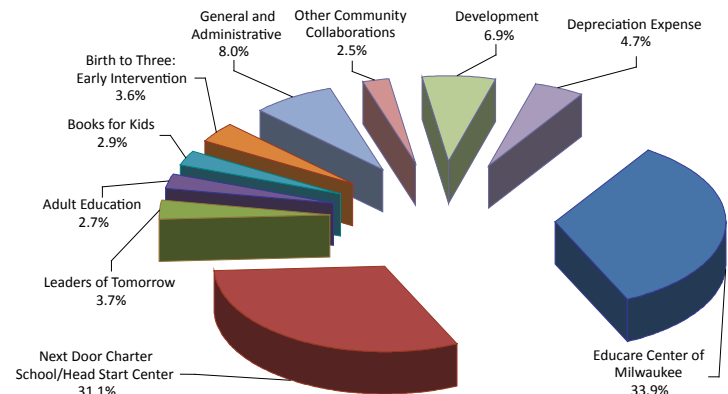

Next Door Foundation PROGRAMS

EARLY CHILDHOOD CAMPUS

EDUCARE CENTER OF MILWAUKEE

Educare focuses on closing the “opportunity gap” between disadvantaged children and their middle-class peers. Based on a national early childhood model, Educare ensures that at-risk children enter kindergarten meeting school-readiness norms. The program provides low child-to-teacher ratios, continuity of care, and equal attention to the child’s cognitive, social, emotional, and physical development.

HEAD START

Head Start is based on the premise that education programs, that dually address family social service needs, best help children from low income families. Head Start works with children 3-5, providing them with health and developmental screenings, nutritional education, and mental health services as needed.

EARLY HEAD START & BIRTH TO THREE

Early Head Start and Birth-to-Three are home-based, early intervention programs. Each program serves pregnant women and families with children up to age three. Birth-to-Three provides special needs services for families of young children with developmental delays. Early Head Start connects families with Parent Educators, who work with them in their homes and through services at Next Door.

NEXT DOOR CHARTER SCHOOL

The Next Door Charter School provides four-year-old and five-year-old kindergarten through a partnership with Milwaukee Public Schools.

COMMUNITY, PARENT AND CHILD EDUCATION PROGRAMS

BOOKS FOR KIDS & READ WITH ME

The Books for Kids program distributes over 100,000 new and gently used books to children annually. The program nurtures an early love for literacy, and promotes family bonding, through reading and enjoying books together. ‘Read with Me’ provides an opportunity for community volunteers to read to children at Next Door.

LEADERS OF TOMORROW

Leaders of Tomorrow is an after-school and summer program for youth ages 5-16. Participants are instructed in leadership, entrepreneurship, life skills and computer literacy. The program also promotes critical thinking and exposes youth to a variety of cultural and recreational activities.

ADULT BASIC EDUCATION / GENERAL EDUCATION DEGREE

(GED) This comprehensive education program helps adult students, with varying academic levels, improve their basic skills. Experienced instructors create individualized and small-group lesson plans, designed to empower each student. Participants receive assistance with GED test preparation, job training, and the achievement of their educational, personal and professional goals.

NEXT DOOR PEDIATRICS

Next Door Pediatrics is a full-service on-site clinic provided through the Children’s Health System. Board-certified pediatricians, Dr. Safavi and Dr. Siddique, work with up to 3,000 children annually.

CHIMC

Children’s Health Improvement for Milwaukee’s Children (CHIMC) is a community-based research project in partnership with Neighborhood House and the Medical College of Wisconsin. CHIMC aims to address and identify the main health issues affecting children living in central city Milwaukee.

UNCOM

United Neighborhood Centers of Milwaukee (UNCOM) is a collaborative partnership of eight community nonprofits, focused on supporting healthy, wholesome and empowered neighborhoods. The partnership includes: Agape Community Center; COA Youth and Family Centers; Journey House; Milwaukee Christian Center; Neighborhood House of Milwaukee; Next Door Foundation; Northcott Neighborhood House; and Silver Spring Neighborhood Center.
